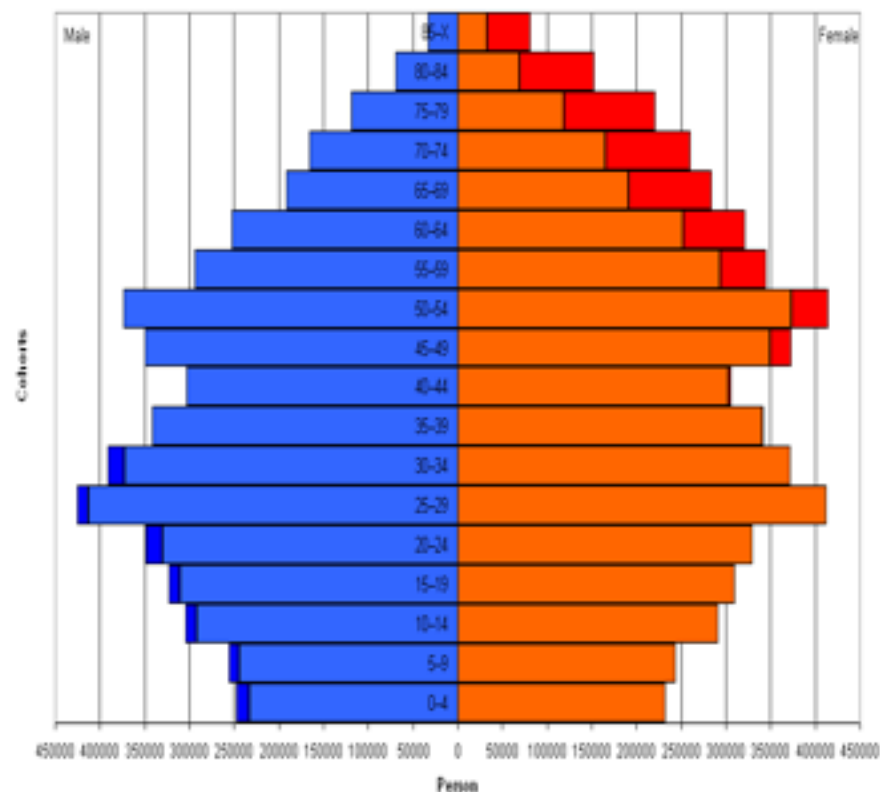


Age structure changes in Hungary, 1901-2050

- Increasing old age dependency ratio

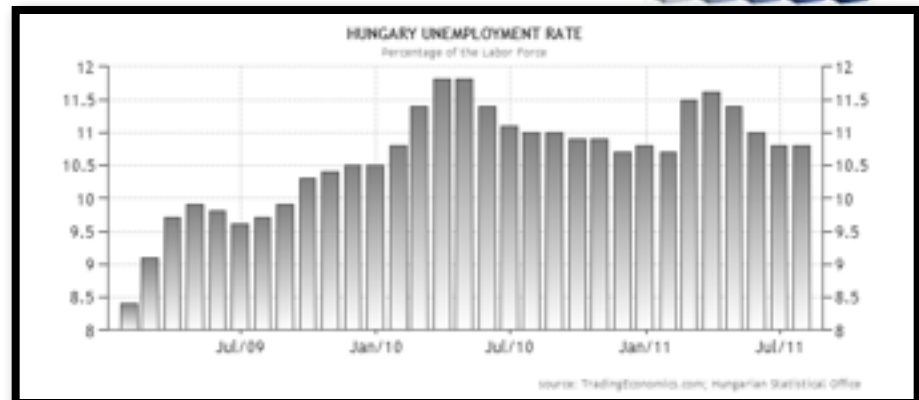


Population pyramid of Hungary (2005)

Many large companies have invested heavily in e-learning and content management systems

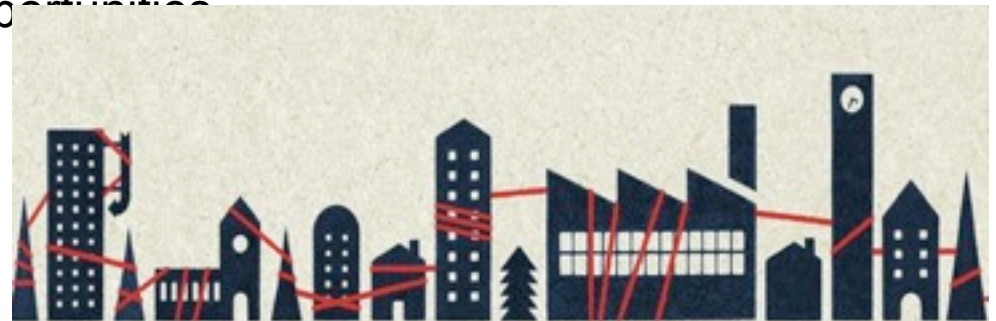
Online societies and networks ensure better social and leisure-time opportunities → more satisfaction with later life due to connections and self-realization

The ICT pedagogy

- Based on a successful programme: „click on it, Granny!” developed by the Budapest Community Center
- Advancing very slowly
- A lot of revision and practice
- 1 person at 1 computer
- The course contains 25 lessons, 2 times a week for 8 weeks,
- The last lesson is the exam - 3 questions via e-mail and they have to send the answers back via email (e.g. search for a night program, train timetable)
- teaching skills to use the Internet and e-mail together with additional basic programs (e.g.: Word, Excel, Power Point)
